

An extra note for larger sponsors:

The CDCRC has put together the parts, partnerships, and community vision to fully implement UGI for a lasting impact in our neighborhoods and neighbors' lives. We are raising the needed funds, but many of the granting and public economic development programs that have expressed a desire to support us require matching funds before they can act to provide financing. To realize our collective dreams we need the help of donors and sponsors during our transition. Commitments of cash, as one-time gifts or for on-going events, are preferred by those agencies to whom we are applying for development support. However, direct support can also take the form of (a) in-kind products and services for our building renovation and expanded incubator space; (b) funds to host larger fund-raising events; (c) funds for general operating and support expenses – helping us keep the lights on and the doors open until we finish the UGI-driven developments.
