The Case Managed Rescue Fund for West Dayton, Ohio residents is a program funded in part by the City of Dayton (HRC), and City Wide Development Corporation. CDCRC has the privilege of managing the cases of the recipients of this fund.

The Case Managed Rescue Fund is a “Forgivable Loan” or “Conditional Grant” available to qualified persons who face eviction and/or foreclosure, or needs assistance with their deposit.

CDCRC will be able to verify if your residence qualifies for this program.

Requirements

- Must be a resident of the City of Dayton
- Residence must be in the (3) West Dayton Priority Board areas; Southwest, Northwest, and Inner West **only. No Exceptions**
- Must have proof of eviction and/or foreclosure mortgage paper work
- Must have income. Must provide proof of income
- CDCRC must be able to verify the amount owed
- Rescue Fund amount can not exceed \$2,000.00
- Rescue Fund will cover rent eviction amount and/or deposit whichever is greater
- Rescue fund will cover modification mortgage deposit amount that does not exceed \$2,100.00
- Must provide landlord contact information and new address if resident is moving and needs assistance on deposit (new residence must be in the City of Dayton/Priority Board areas per RF)
- Must attend all financial literacy sessions for 18 months provided by the CDCRC
- Can only utilize the Rescue Fund once (1 time) per household
- Rent/Mortgage will not be paid if financial assistance from another local agency has been received in the same calendar year
